

Ethel Mae Hocker Scholarship Application

The Ethel Mae Hocker Scholarship is being offered to high achieving incoming middle school students of good character who would like to attend Christ the King Regional School as a new student but need financial assistance to do so. The EMHF scholarship is designed to give deserving students a life changing opportunity to discover, define and develop their full potential in a superior learning environment. Financial need is an underpinning factor in selecting scholars.

There are three parts to completing this application: Each is equally important and no candidate will be considered unless all three components are present. They are:

- I. Written Application information and answers
- II. Supporting Documents (5)
- III. Signed Memo of Understanding

The finished application should be placed in a large manila envelope addressed c/o Ethel Mae Hocker Foundation Scholarship and then mailed or brought to Christ the King Regional School 164 Hopkins Ave. Haddonfield NJ 08033. All applications are due by June 7, 2013.

- I. The written portion of the scholarship is to be the work and words of the applicant. Please answer all the questions thoughtfully and thoroughly. You must answer all questions. Applications may be handwritten or typed. Please take care to be neat.
- II. Five supportive documents are needed:
 1. Letter of academic recommendation from your current school
 2. Letter of character reference(coach, pastor, scout leader, or another extra-curricular activity supervisor that is not related to the child
 3. Letter of support from your parent(s) stating why you would be an excellent candidate for this scholarship to CKRS and how this scholarship will help you realize your full potential.
 4. Financial need statement from parents and supportive confirming documentation if selected (Confidential self reporting online document will be required to be submitted)
 5. A sample piece of graded work from this academic year that you are proud of and that reflects your academic interests and/ or ability. This sample of your work could be a book or lab report, science or math project, essay or another special assignment. The sample SHOULD NOT be a test, a regular homework assignment, or a group project. The submitted work does not have to be perfect! Your teacher's comments and grading are not considered.
- III. The letter of Understanding must be signed by you and your parents. Your affixed signatures will signify that you all understand the purpose and privilege attached to being a Hocker Scholar and meet the conditions as well as accept the responsibilities attached to this award.
